Angelo Moretto, M.D, Ph.D

Prof. Angelo Moretto is a medical doctor and a professor at the University of Milan. He earned a Medical Degree at the University of Padua in 1981 and, at the same university, he entered the Postgraduate School in Occupational Medicine, from which he obtained a Specialist Diploma in 1986. In 1987 he completed a Ph.D. in Occupational Health & Industrial Hygiene. His main research activities include basic toxicological research and the monitoring of occupational and accidental exposure to chemical agents; in particular, he has written many reports, papers and book chapters on occupational toxicology. Prof. Angelo Moretto is a member of many international committees for the risk assessment of exposure to chemical substances, such as the Toxicological Core Assessment Group at the Joint FAO/WHO Meeting on Pesticide Residues, Geneva (Switzerland)/Rome (Italy), and, since 2011 he has also been a board member of the Società Italiana di Medicina del Lavoro e Igiene Industriale. Moreover, starting from 2010 he has been involved, both as a participant and as a coordinator, in many projects in the field of toxicology, but also food safety. He is currently a lecturer in Occupational Health and Occupational Toxicology at the Post-graduate school of Occupational Medicine at the University of Milan and since 2006 he is also Director of the International Center for Pesticides and Health Risk Prevention of the University Hospital “ASST Fatebenefratelli Sacco” in Milan, Italy.
